You are invited to attend the Public Open House to learn more about the work completed to date and the next steps in the process.

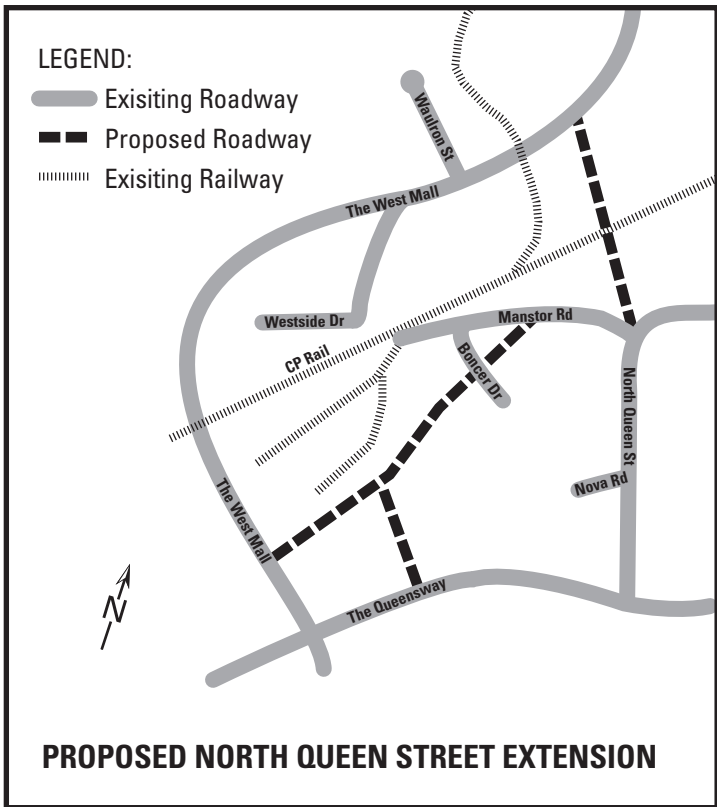
