Replacement of Watermain on Aukland Road (NOTE: Weekend Hours and Road Closure)

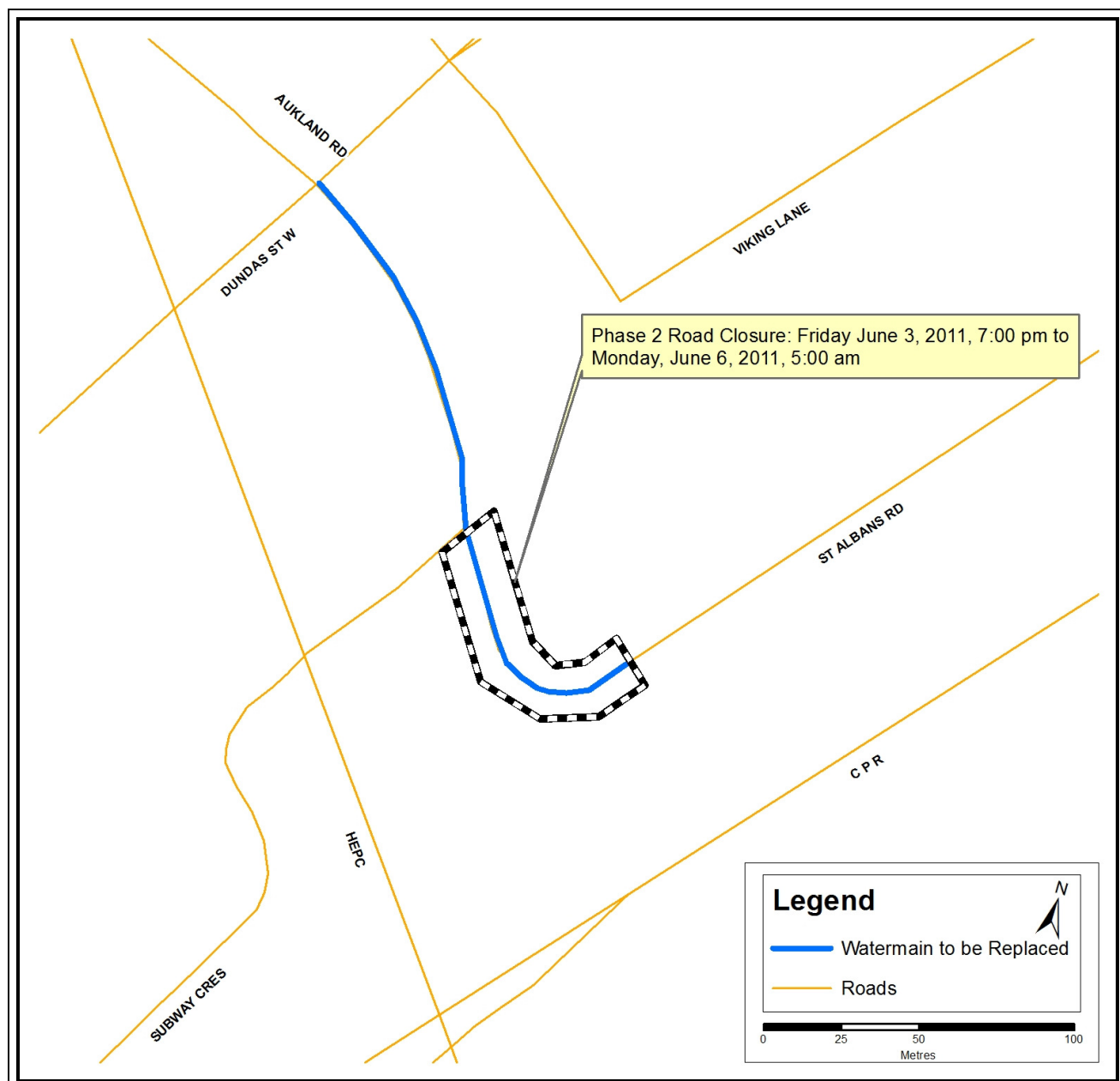
A Construction Notice was previously issued on April 27, 2011, advising of the above noted project's work area and hours of construction. This Construction Notice Update is being issued to advise you of the change in construction schedule for Phase 2 due to the inclement weather forecast for this weekend. This weekend's planned road closure (i.e.: May 13 to May 16) has been cancelled and Aukland Road will be open to all traffic. Phase 2 is now scheduled to commence on Friday, June 3, 2011 starting at 7:00 pm and ending at 5:00 am on Monday, June 6, 2011. Aukland Road will be closed to all traffic within Phase 2 during this time. Please refer to the map on this page for location.

The above-noted project is part of a City-wide watermain replacement program. This watermain is being replaced to ensure the continuous supply of safe drinking water.

The City of Toronto has retained R.V. Anderson Associates Limited to manage the program.

The General Contractor for the project is 614128 Ontario Ltd. o/a Trisan Construction.

Construction Details

- The replacement of the watermain will involve the installation of temporary water services; the installation of new pipes; disinfecting and flushing of the new pipes; transferring water service

connections from the old to the new watermain; replacement of substandard water services on City property; and restoring areas disturbed during construction. Temporary disruptions to the water supply will occur during the construction period. Further notice will be given prior to any scheduled water supply disruption and residents and businesses will be informed if additional precautions are to be taken during the water supply disruptions.

- During construction, noise and vibration should be expected during working hours. All efforts will be made to minimize this and other disruptions to the local community.

Disruptions

- Phase 2 Road Closure: Auckland Road will be completely closed to all traffic between Subway Crescent and St. Albans Road on Friday, June 3, 2011 starting at 7:00 pm and ending at 5:00 am on Monday, June 6, 2011. Please see map for the limits of Phase 2.
- At certain times during the work, vehicle and pedestrian traffic may be disrupted. Signs will be posted to advise of detours, lane closures and pedestrian crossings.
- Access to driveways and sidewalks may be restricted at times to allow for construction. Residents and businesses will be advised by on-site personnel.
- Emergency (police, fire and medical response) access will be maintained at all times.
- Recycling and garbage collection will not be affected. Please follow your normal routine.
- On-street parking may be restricted during the daytime. Affected residents may park on adjacent streets. Residents are advised not to park where on-street parking is prohibited. There will be no consideration for parking offences in areas designated as No Stopping, No Standing, Stopping on Sidewalks or Boulevards, by Fire Hydrants, Fire Routes, Rush Hour Routes and parking within 9 metres of intersections.

Important Advisories

- Residents and businesses are advised that they may have to remove any unique landscaping and/or lawn sprinkler systems that are located on the City portion of their property before work begins, as well as delay any improvements to driveways until construction is completed. If you have a lawn sprinkler system on the City portion of your property, please contact R.V. Anderson Associates Limited (see below for contact information) to arrange for a site inspection. If your landscaping requires removal, then R.V. Anderson Associates Limited will advise you of that.

Work Hours

- In addition to the work hours identified on the previous Construction Notice (April 27, 2011), work will also be carried out between Subway Crescent and St. Albans Road on the evening of Friday, June 3, 2011 commencing at 7:00 pm and ending at approximately 5:00 am on Monday, June 6, 2011. During this time, Auckland Road will be closed to all traffic between Subway Crescent and St. Albans Road.
