Replacement of Watermains on Ashbourne Drive, Botfield Avenue, Charleston Road, Goswell Road, and Prennan Avenue

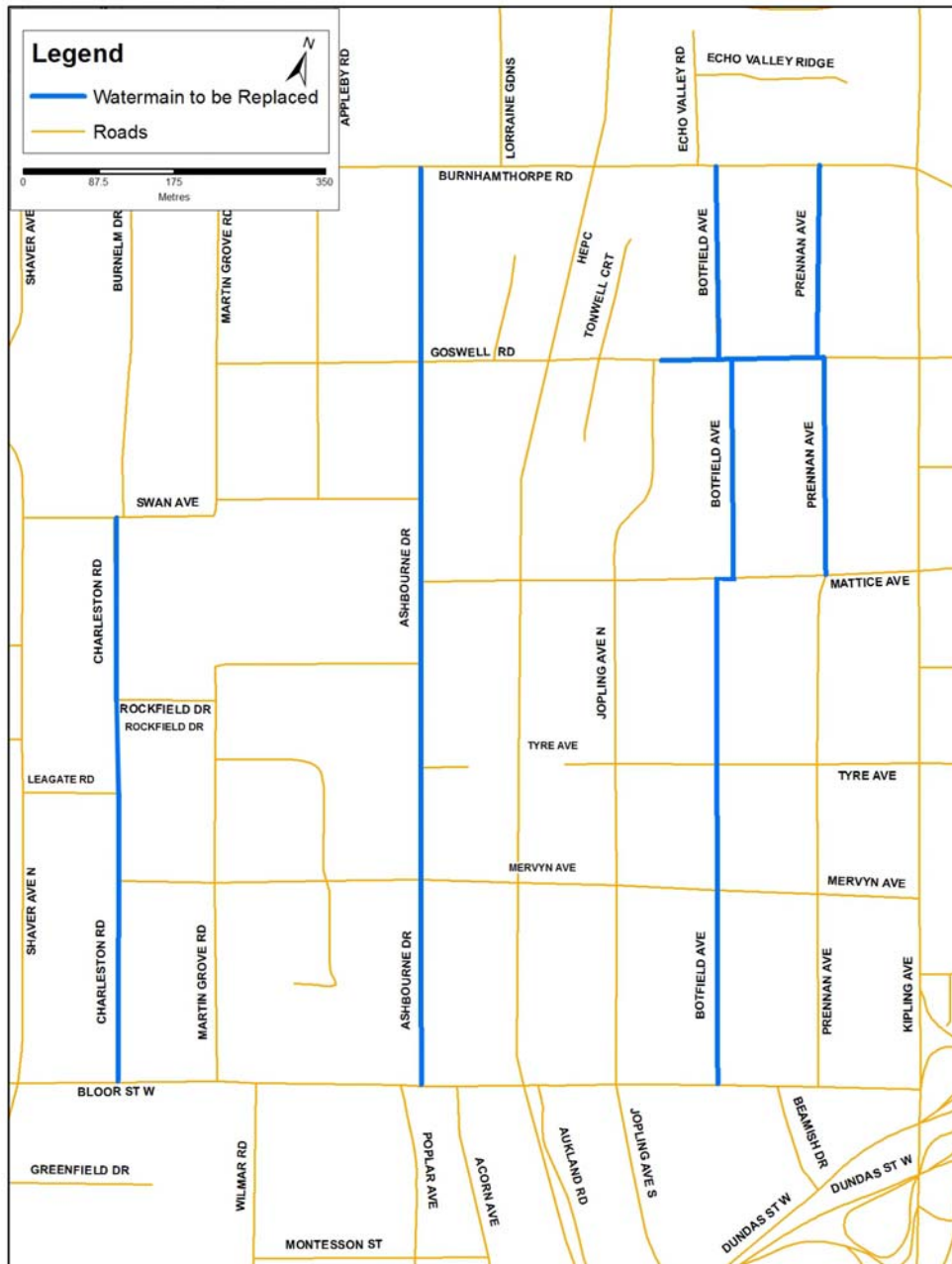
Expected Project Start Date: March 28, 2011
Expected Completion Date: September 30, 2011

The above-noted project is part of a City-wide watermain replacement program. These watermains are being replaced to ensure the continuous supply of safe drinking water. Please refer to the map on this page for location.

The City of Toronto has retained R.V. Anderson Associates Limited to manage the program.

The General Contractor for the project is 614128 Ontario Ltd. o/a Trisan Construction.

Construction Details

- The replacement of the watermain will involve the installation of temporary water services on Ashbourne Drive and Charleston Road; the installation of new pipes; disinfecting and flushing of the new pipes; transferring water service connections from the old to the new watermain; replacement of substandard water services on City

property; and restoring areas disturbed during construction. Temporary disruptions to the water supply will occur during the construction period. Further notice will be given prior to any scheduled water supply disruption and residents and businesses will be informed if additional precautions are to be taken during the water supply disruptions.

- During construction, noise and vibration should be expected during working hours. All efforts will be made to minimize this and other disruptions to the local community.

Disruptions

- At certain times during the work, vehicle and pedestrian traffic may be disrupted. Signs will be posted to advise of detours, lane closures and pedestrian crossings.
- Access to driveways and sidewalks may be restricted at times to allow for construction. Residents and businesses will be advised by on-site personnel.
- Emergency (police, fire and medical response) access will be maintained at all times.
- Recycling and garbage collection will not be affected. Please follow your normal routine.
- On-street parking may be restricted during the daytime. Affected residents may park on adjacent streets. Residents are advised not to park where on-street parking is prohibited. There will be no consideration for parking offences in areas designated as No Stopping, No Standing, Stopping on Sidewalks or Boulevards, by Fire Hydrants, Fire Routes, Rush Hour Routes and parking within 9 metres of intersections.

Important Advisories

- Residents and businesses are advised that they may have to remove any unique landscaping and/or lawn sprinkler systems that are located on the City portion of their property before work begins, as well as delay any improvements to driveways until construction is completed. If you have a lawn sprinkler system on the City portion of your property, please contact R.V. Anderson Associates Limited (see below for contact information) to arrange for a site inspection. If your landscaping requires removal, then R.V. Anderson Associates Limited will advise you of that.
- OZA Inspections Ltd., under contract to Trisan Construction, will survey all houses within the construction area prior to the start of work. The survey is on a voluntary basis, however it provides a record of the condition of your house prior to construction so that any damage that might occur during construction can be quantified. The survey will include an inspection of both the inside and outside of all houses to assess existing conditions. OZA Inspections Ltd. will deliver a separate notice to set up survey appointments. All inspection staff will be wearing photo identification and carrying photographic equipment during the survey.

Work Hours

- Generally, work will take place between 7:00 am to 7:00 pm, Monday to Friday, but occasionally it will be necessary to carry out work in the evenings, overnight, and on weekends. Work will not take place during statutory or other major holiday observances.
