Park Lawn Road The Queensway to Lake Shore Boulevard West Road Widening and Resurfacing, and Sidewalk Construction

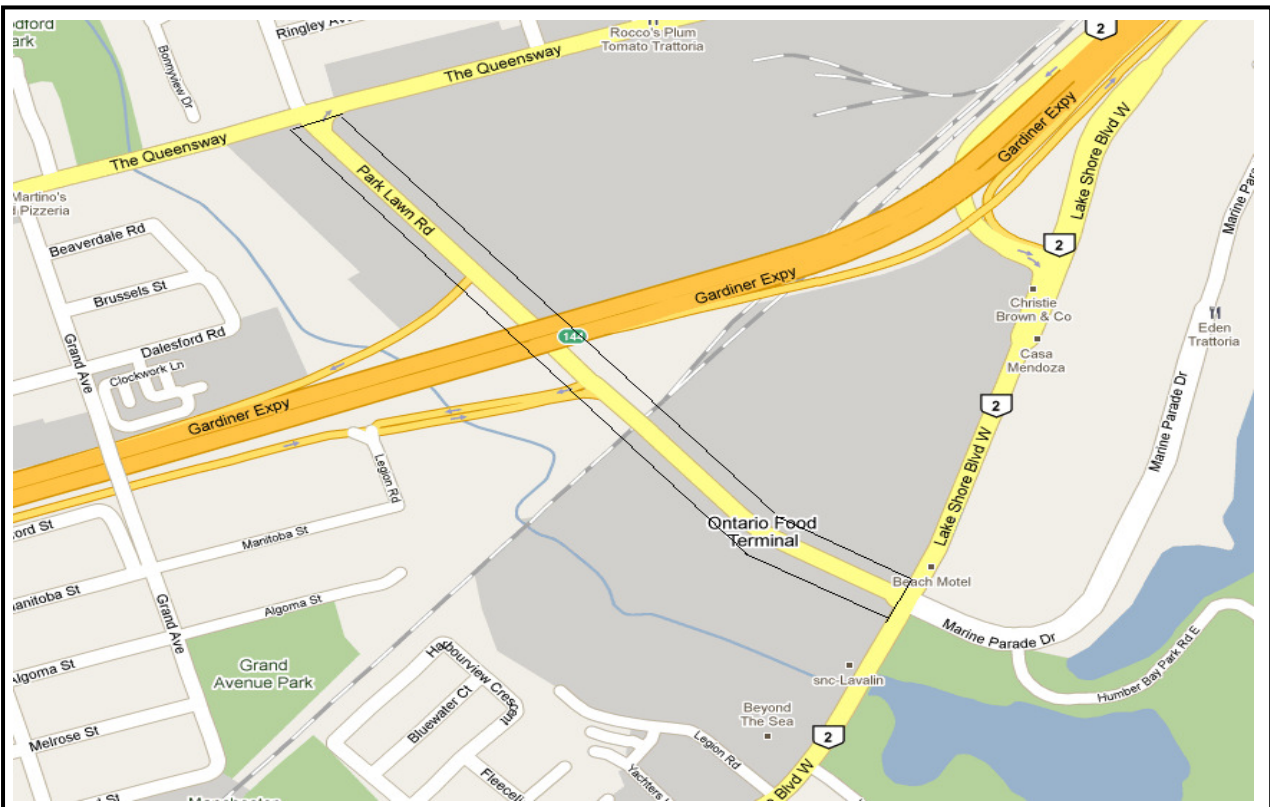
Expected Project Start Date: May 16, 2011
Expected Completion Date: August 24, 2011

The City of Toronto will be resurfacing the road, adding turning lane and constructing new east side sidewalks in order to ensure that it continues to operate in safe and efficient manner. This project is part of the Council-approved 2011 Capital Works Program.

This work will take place on Park Lawn Road from The Queensway to Lake Shore Boulevard West. A map showing the work area is included below.

Your co-operation and patience during the construction period is crucial and will be appreciated.

Construction Details

- Road resurfacing of Park Lawn Road from The Queensway to the C.N.R Bridge, this work also includes construction of median/ traffic islands and the replacement of deficient curbs and sidewalks.
- Road widening of Park Lawn Road at the southbound approach to the westbound Gardiner Expressway on-ramp in order to construct a dedicated right-turn lane.
- Construction of new sidewalks on the east side of Park Lawn Road between The Queensway and Lake Shore Boulevard West and permanent restoration of all areas impacted by construction.

You will be notified if there are any significant changes to the construction schedule or work to be undertaken.

Work Hours

Work will typically take place from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. from Monday to Friday, with work after hours and on weekends as required.

Disruptions

As with all construction projects, there will be noise and temporary inconveniences. In order to complete the work effectively and in a safe manner, some pedestrian and traffic restrictions will be necessary. These include a reduction to one traffic lane in each direction, as required. The contractor will further notify you of any temporary disruptions. Every effort will be made to reduce the inconvenience. The City appreciates your understanding and co-operation.

Parking Restrictions & Allowances

Construction may require temporary closure of private driveways. Where the property has two entrances, one entrance will be kept open at all times. Further notice will be given prior to the temporary closure.
