



Councillor Peter Milczyn's Town Hall Meeting "Potential Future Traffic Impact on Dundas West"

I invite you to a Town Hall Meeting to discuss traffic along Dundas West and Shorncliffe with regards to future potential development and growth in the area.

City Staff and the Applicants for developments at Dundas Street West and Shorncliffe Road will join me at this Town Hall to discuss how the current road infrastructure will absorb these proposed projects. If you have concerns about future development and how it may impact you, I would like to encourage you to attend - I want to hear your input and feedback.

Background:

Two rezoning applications have been submitted to replace the existing low-rise industrial, office and commercial buildings at 5415 to 5487 Dundas Street West and 15 and 25 Shorncliffe Road with seven residential condominium towers. These proposals fall within the Etobicoke City Centre area. Also the owners of the Honeydale Mall and Metro Grocers properties have filed Official Plan Amendment applications (which are under appeal to the Ontario Municipal Board) for future residential, mixed use, and office developments south of Dundas from Shorncliffe to Highway 427. These various applications have been thoroughly studied to understand the traffic impacts they will generate. Residents have requested more information on these results.
