## Night Work at Kipling Station – Update

This is further to TTC's Night Work Update notice dated May 13, 2010 relating to the construction of the new east entrance building to the TTC's Kipling subway station.

### Next:

Installation of wall panels and glass on the pre-fabricated bridge is scheduled for Sunday, May 30 and Sunday, June 6. In addition, other night work during the May 29<sup>th</sup> weekend is required for concrete repairs to the platform of a bus bay situated at the east end of the Kipling Station bus platform.

### Weekend Work and Night Work to Bus Bay: From Saturday, May 29 to Monday, May 31

Repairs to the concrete bus bay platforms are required to be carried out on a weekend, during periods of reduced service, when bus capacity is available at alternate bays for displaced routes. Work on bus bay #8 has therefore been scheduled during the May 29<sup>th</sup> weekend. **Work will be around-the-clock** in order to ensure that the bus bay will be available for full service the following Monday, May 31. The noisiest activity involving concrete saw-cutting and concrete breaking/removal is being scheduled during the **daytime on Saturday, May 29 starting at approximately 6:30 a.m.** in order to minimize disruption. Some of the repair work that will carry into the night will include forming work and the pouring of concrete. Noise from hammering and concrete trucks may be evident.

During the closure of bus platform # 8, buses operating on the 30 LAMBTON and 46 MARTIN GROVE routes will be reassigned to other platforms at the Kipling Station.

### Night Work Schedule for Installation of Wall Panels and Glass:

As previously scheduled, night work for the wall panels and glass of the pre fabricated bridge will begin shortly after **2:30 a.m. and continue through to approximately 8:00 a.m.** when the subway trains are not scheduled to operate into the station. Night work is scheduled as follows:

**Sunday, May 30, 2010**

**Sunday, June 6, 2010**

**Sunday, June 13, 2010, (may be required)**

**Note:** *In the event of a schedule change due to unforeseen circumstances, notice of alternate dates to complete this work will be provided. As previously mentioned, we will advise you once the subsequent nightshift for asphalt paving has been scheduled.*

### Noise/Controls:

Construction noise will be apparent when certain construction equipment is in full operation. Some noise may also be generated from construction trucks, scissor lifts, etc. The work will be supervised by Bondfield Construction with TTC Construction personnel on site for the duration of the work.
