



# CONSTRUCTION NEWS

## Night Work at Kipling Station Sunday, March 7 and Monday, March 8, 2010

Construction of the new east entrance building to the TTC's Kipling subway station is continuing. The next phase involves the installation of a prefabricated bridge and walkway structures. Due to the nature of this work; the close proximity to the subway main line tracks and the need to occupy and block the bus ramp with a crane, the work has been scheduled to be conducted during the early morning hours of Sunday, March 7 and Monday, March 8.

### **Scope of Work**

The work will include:

- Closure of the Kipling Station Bus Loop commencing at 2:30 a.m.;
- Set-up of a mobile crane on the bus laneway near the eastern extent of Kipling Station;
- Temporary staging of trailers in the eastbound lane of St. Albans Road;
- Rigging and hoisting of heavy materials for the bridge and walkway structures; and
- Securing of the structures in their permanent location east of Kipling Station.

### **Night Work Schedule**

Two nightshifts are scheduled to complete this work. Work will begin shortly after **2:30 a.m. on Sunday, March 7 and continue through to approximately 8:00 a.m., and on Monday, March 8 from approximately 2:30 a.m. to 5:00 a.m.** when the subway trains and buses are not scheduled to operate into the station.

**Note:** *In the event of a schedule change due to unforeseen circumstances, notice of alternate dates to complete this work will be provided.*

### **Noise**

Construction noise will be apparent when the heavy machinery is in full operation. Some noise may also be generated from construction trucks and the use of hand-held power tools

### **Controls**

The work will be supervised by Bondfield Construction. TTC Construction personnel will also be on site for the duration of the work. Traffic control, including paid duty police officers, will be provided as required.
