### **Berry Road Directional Closure Postponed**

It was decided that given the current weather conditions and the unpredictability of future weather conditions, the directional closure of Berry Rd will be postponed until Spring 2008. With that being said, changes to the northbound routing are to be implemented "immediately" in an attempt to provide better service to the local community. The new northbound routing is to be a mirror reflection of the southbound routing.

The northbound routing to be; *from The Queensway - north on Park Lawn Rd, east \ north on Kinsdale Blvd., west on Berry Rd to proceed over regular northbound routing.*
